Tools You Will Need



Tape Measure



Notepad & Pencil

Pro Tip

Record all your measurements in inches instead of feet and inches. This will save you time later. All cabinet and appliance sizes are listed in inches.

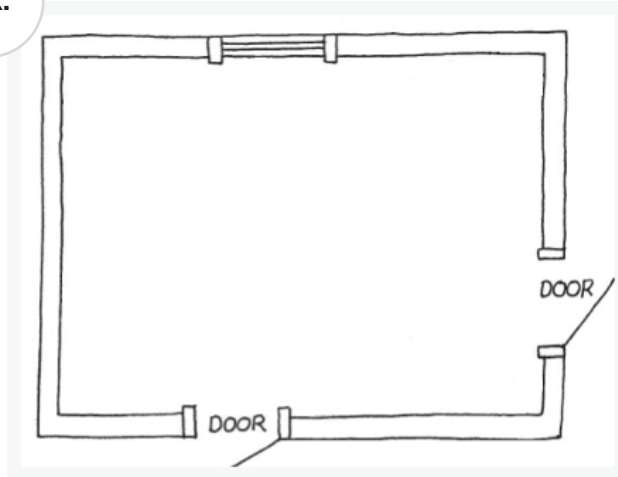
For instance a three foot base cabinet is a Base 36 or B36.



Sketch your Kitchen.

Create a rough birds or plan eye view sketch of your kitchen.

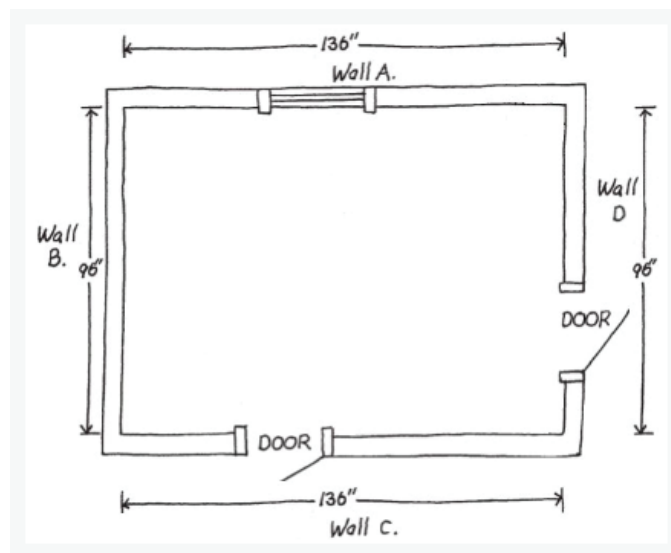




Measure the walls.

Measure each wall. You will need the Width and Height dimensions. For each wall make a note of any soffits or pipes that hang down on the wall. Update your sketch with your measurements.

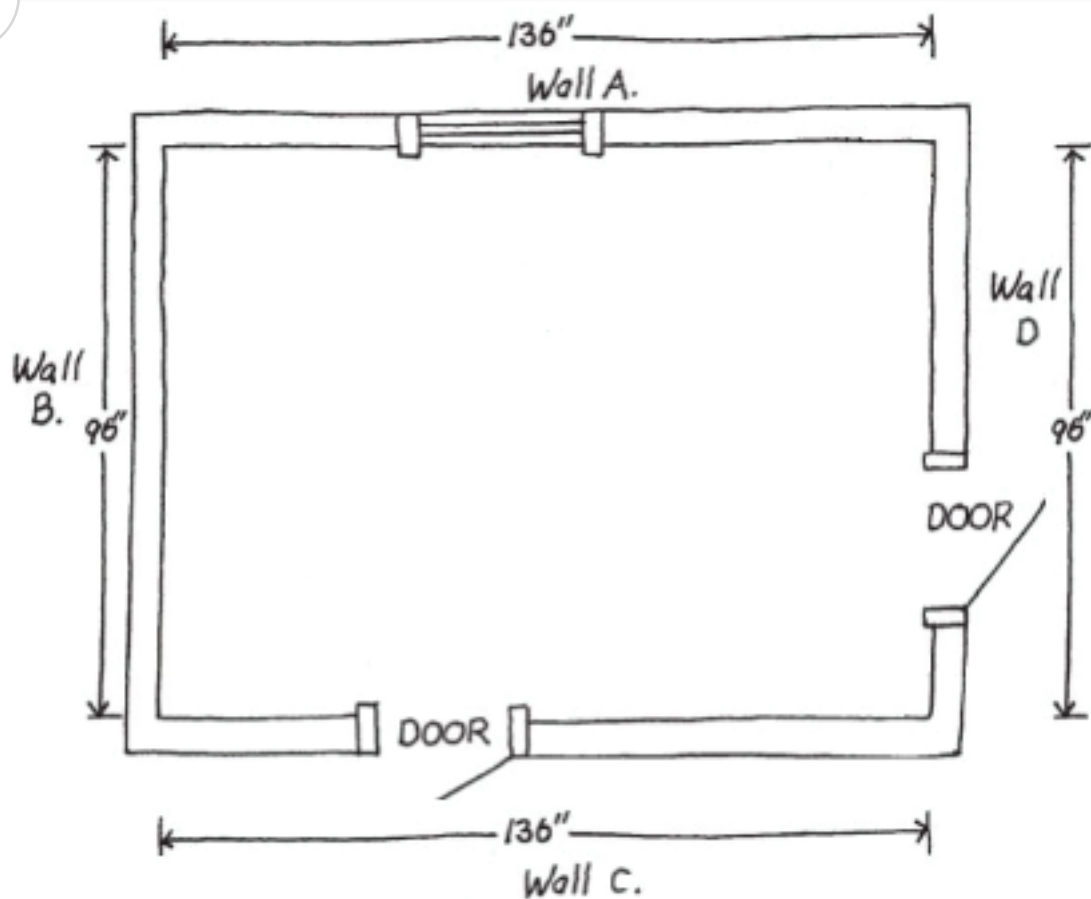


Measure the windows and door openings and where they are located on the wall.

Update your sketch with your measurements.

Wall A has a window that is 36 in wide and 44 in tall. It is located 42 in from the Wall BA corner. The bottom of the window is 36 in from the floor.

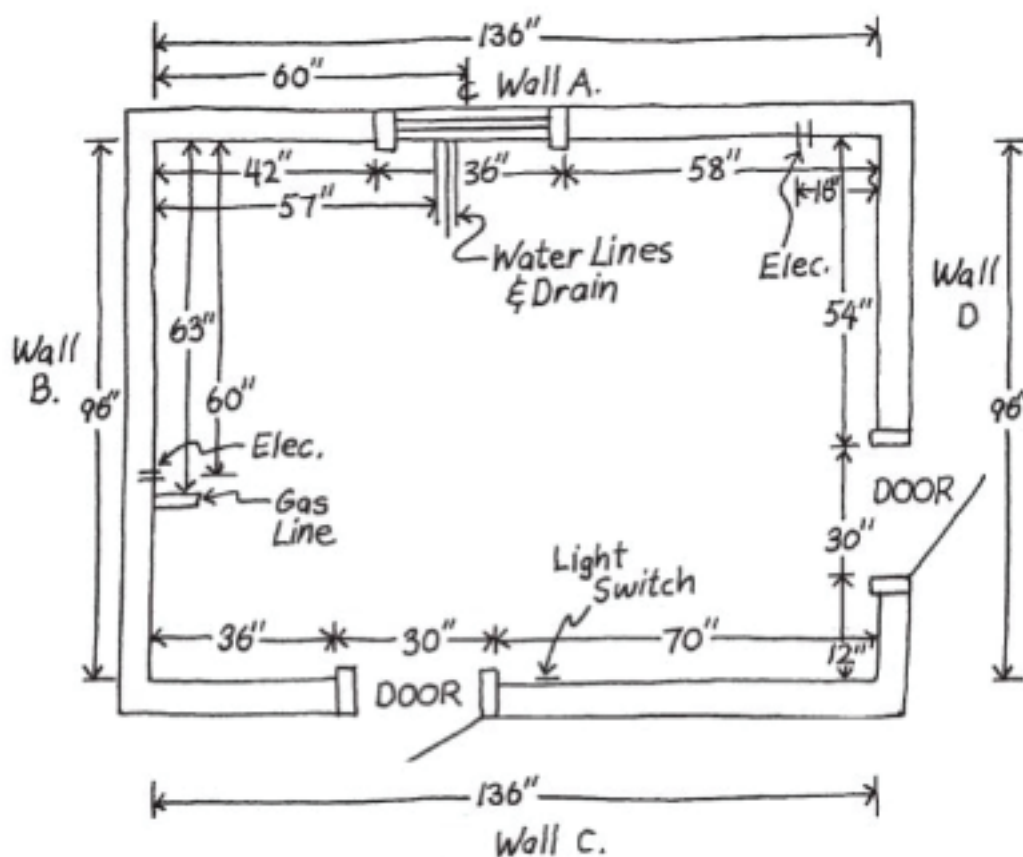
Measure the where the outlets, plumbing,
& gas lines are located on the wall.

Update your sketch with your measurements.

Wall A has a water line and drain located 57 in from the WallBA corner.

Wall A has an electrical out- let located 18 in from the WallAD corner.

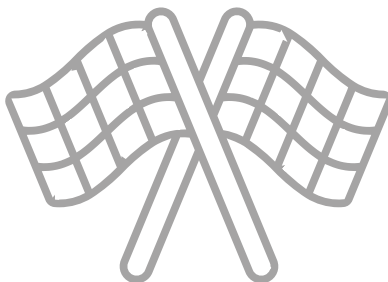
